## **SCRA Points System and Lineup - 2012**

- On the first day of the season the line up will be made by the draw from a hat. Every other day will be made from the total points for the season. If not out on first race day the car will start at back for that day until points are accumulated. New drivers or any driver can start at back as many times as they want.
- 2. If you started in Heat A you will remain in Heat A for the entire day. If you started in Heat B you will remain in Heat B for the entire day. Starting at the front will be the lower finishers and the rear of the pack will be the top place finishers from the first Heat.
- 3. Feature race line up will be made by a point's average of the season up to that race day. Total points for season divided by the total number of race days raced, where the high point cars would start at the back and the lower point cars would start at the front.
- 4. If you do not start the first heat, you will be placed at the back of heat 2B.
- 5. If you receive a black flag, you will lose your points for that race.
- 6. If you are black flagged in the first heat, you will be starting at the back of heat 2B.
- 7. On a caution, you will be lined up according to the last lap completed. If there is a lapped car(s) that haven't crossed the finish line yet, but all those on the lead lap have, we will go according to that lap.
- 8. If you did not start a race, you cannot enter it after they have received the green flag.
- 9. The length of a race will depend on how many cars are in the heat.
  - a. If there are 5 or under cars in the heat, you will do 7 laps
  - b. If there are 6 or more cars in the heat, you will do 10 laps
- 10. In the feature race, the amount of laps will be determined by the number of
  - a. The length of the race will be the number of cars times 2 plus 2, but there will be no more than 25 laps completed, and not less than 15 laps.
- 11. Points received in the heats will be as follows:
  - a. A heat win will be worth 10 points. Each car placing behind the winner will receive 1 less point for each car in order of finish. Example: Heat winner 10 points, second 9 points, third 8 points and so on. The points will roll back by 1.
  - b. This point system will apply to each individual heat.

- 12. Points in the feature will be as follows:
  - a. A feature win will be worth 30 points. Each car placing behind the winner will receive 2 less points for each car in order of finish.
    Example: Feature winner 30 points, second 28 points, third 26 points and so on. The points will roll back by 2.
- 13. If cars are tied in points, the positioning will be decided by flipping a coin.
  - a. If more than 2 cars are tied, it will be decided by drawing from a hat.
